CONTEST RULES

- **Who is eligible?** Any **K-12 students**, who attend NTPS. 1 entry per student.
- **How do I enter?** Read the contest rules and submit your art piece to NTPS Community Relations (contact info below).

CONTEST RULES & CRITERIA

- Image – **original images** only! No copyrighted images, symbols or slogans will be selected (e.g. Peanuts characters, SpongeBob, Disney).
- Flat 2-D art pieces only.
- One art piece submission per student.
- Use of space – **Horizontal images are required.**
- Content – images should reflect the 2019-20 district theme, “Stronger Together.”
- Any text included with the image **must be neatly written and spelled correctly.**
- Students **should NOT put their name directly on the artwork,** but do need to fill out the attached parent permission form (if you are 18, you do not need to fill this form out).
- Include a quote with your art piece – Why is it better to be “stronger together” – why working together is better than alone?
- Note: Multimedia, collages, photography and graphic design are all acceptable
- Submit your art piece to your school’s art teacher.

Selection process:

- From the entries submitted, a committee of district representatives will select 12 final art pieces – 4 elementary, 4 middle and 4 high school winners (potentially).

Prizes:

- Each winner will have their artwork published in the 2019-20 “Stronger Together” NTPS calendar and receive extra complimentary copies.
- \$25 gift card to Michael’s Craft Store
