### Kindergarten

### First Grade

#### Please label supplies with student's first name

1 empty, 1-inch, 3-ring binder (*plastic or cardboard*)

1 spiral notebook—wide-ruled composition

1 large zippered pencil pouch for three-ring binder

5 folders with bottom pockets inside. Need one red, one blue, one yellow and one green. Fifth folder color can be student's choice / plastic preferred (**NO brads, please**)

1 school box (*no longer than 9 inches*)

1 traditional backpack (no wheels)

1 pair kid's scissors

#### Please do not label the following (they are shared items)

8 black fine-point dry erase markers (available at office - supply stores)

24 #2 yellow pencils

1 box of markers

1 box of colored pencils

4 large pink erasers

4 small glue sticks

2 boxes of crayons— 24 count

#### Optional Supplies:

1 box gallon size zipper bags (Last name A-L ONLY)

1 box sandwich size zipper bags (Last name M-Z ONLY)

1 container of **unscented** baby wipes

2 boxes of facial tissue

1 eight color watercolor paint set

## Second Grade

### Please label supplies with student's first name

- 1 backpack/book bag – **No Wheels (must fit in cubby)**
- 4 folders with bottom pocket inside
- 1 (1inch) 3-ring binder
- 1 box crayons- 16 or 24 count
- 1 box colored pencils- 8 count
- 1 box of colored markers
- 1 small school supply box
- 1 pair sharp-pointed scissors
- 3 Composition Notebooks-wide ruled (*no spiral or neat books*)

### Please do not label the following (they are shared items)

- 8 black ***fine point dry erase markers***
- 2 glue sticks
- 36 #2 pencils
- 2 or 3 large pink erasers

### Optional Supplies:

- 2 large boxes of **unscented** facial tissue
- 2 containers of **unscented** baby wipes
- 1 box snack size zipper bags (Last name A-L ONLY)
- 1 box gallon size zipper bags (Last name M-Z ONLY)

## Third Grade

- 5 pocket folders w/ bottom pockets (*no brads*)
- 2 sturdy plastic pocket folders w/ bottom pockets (*w/ brads*)
- 2 pkgs. of notebook paper (loose leaf, wide ruled)
- 1 box of crayons, 16 or 24 count
- 40 #2 pencils - do not label
- 1 pair of sharp-pointed scissors
- 1 small school box (8"x 5 ½")
- 2 packages of eraser caps
- 2 large pink erasers
- 1 book-bag or backpack (no wheels)
- 1 hard plastic ruler with centimeters and inches
- 1 9"x 12" clipboard
- 1 pencil size highlighter
- 1 box of colored pencils –16 count
- 12 black, **fine point** DRY erase marker pens (not Vis a Vis)
- 6 glue sticks
- 1 bottle white school glue (4 oz.)
- 7 Spiral Notebooks

### Optional Supplies:

- containers of **unscented** baby wipes
- boxes of tissues
- box sandwich size zipper bags
- box gallon size zipper bags

## Fourth Grade

- 4 composition notebooks (Approx. 100 pages) **No Spiral**
- 4 packs of notebook paper (3-hole punch, wide ruled)
- 1 book bag or back pack (no wheels) – Label with name.
- 1 small school box (for pencils/supplies)
- 48 #2 pencils
- 2 red ballpoint pens
- 1 highlighter (any color)
- 2 packs of black dry erase markers
- 1 pack of colored markers (**fine-point, 10-count**)
- 1 pack of colored pencils
- 1 pair of sharp-pointed scissors
- 1 large pink eraser
- 4 glue sticks
- 1 ruler with **centimeters and inches**
- A small re-useable water bottle to have in class
- 6 pocket folders (vinyl preferred)

### Optional Items:

- Boxes of Facial Tissue
- Unscented** Baby Wipes

## Fifth Grade

- 1 two-inch, three-ring binder (**NO zipper/Velcro**)
- \*2 pkgs. of notebook paper (*3-hole punch, wide-ruled*)
- 1 pair of sharp-pointed scissors
- 1 school box
- 2 soft pink erasers
- 1 bottle of white school glue, 4 oz.
- 2 glue sticks
- \*48 or more #2 pencils
- 2 black whiteboard markers
- \*2 ballpoint pens (*1 red, 1 blue*)
- 2 highlighter – 2 different colors
- 1 box crayons—16 count
- 1 box of colored pencils and/or fine-point markers, 10-count
- 1 ruler with **centimeters and inches**
- 1 set of notebook dividers, 5-Tab
- 4 composition notebooks (*9-¾" x 7-½" for journal writing*)
- 4 folders with bottom pockets inside

- 1 container of **unscented** baby wipes
- 1 large box of tissues
