Outcome: Increased growth rates of underperforming groups eliminating achievement and opportunity gaps.

Academic Gap Goal: 50% of students with an IEP, scoring below the 50%ile on the fall Passage Reading Fluency easyCBM in grades 2-5, will improve at least one risk level by spring (high risk to some risk, some risk to low risk).

Indicators of Progress:

Winter Easy CBM Scores show:

- 79% of students 1-5 grade are above the 26th percentile in passage reading fluency.
- 49% of 1-5 grade students receiving special education services are above the 26th percentile in passage reading fluency.

Concern Area:

• 51% of 1-5 grade students receiving special education services are below the 25th percentile in passage reading fluency.

Next Steps:

- Embed student fluency scores, supports and strategies in MDT meetings.
- Continue collaboration meetings between SPED and General Education teachers with a focus on student growth.
- Progress monitor students who are scoring below the 25th percentile in passage reading fluency twice a month.
- Support the SIP by engaging in learning walks to align best practices in reading.

Outcome: Increase percentage of regular school attenders

SEL Gap Goal: The gap for regular attendance between students identified as American Indian/Alaska Native compared to our school average will decrease by 50% from June 2023 to June 2024 at each grade level.

- Regular attenders have increased for all grades when compared to the 2022-2023 school year.
- Student specific comments were included in progress reports for students who were chronically absent.
- 92 personal connections with families around attendance

Concern Area:

35% of students at Olympic View are regular attenders for the month of January.

Next Steps:

- Support the SIP by engaging in learning walks to assure positive classroom environments and meaningful connections.
- Continue to partner with families to discuss the importance of attendance and removing barriers to getting students to school.
- Intentional communication with students who are chronically absent during conference week to ensure a strong finish of regular attendance.
