Strategic Plan Goal: Continuous Growth – All Students, All Subjects

Outcome: a. Increased percentage of students demonstrating proficiency on standards/ c. Increased growth rate for students experiencing personal and/or systemic barriers to achievement or opportunity

Academic Gap Goal: Students in grades 3-5 receiving Title I math services will score at or above proficiency on the Math Smarter Balanced Assessment (SBA) by Spring of 2024.

Indicators of Progress: We are using Winter Easy CBM data to project how many students are likely to pass the SBA in spring of 2024. Scores at or above the 50th percentile on CBM benchmark assessments have a strong positive correlation to scores at or above benchmark on SBA.

3rd Grade

- Four students exited from Title I math support after winter Easy CBM, indicating they were at grade level with math skills.
- Students served in Title Math who are at or near the 50th percentile on Easy CBM increased by 15% from fall to winter.

4th Grade

- Students served in Title Math who are at or near the 50th percentile on Easy CBM increased by 50% from fall to winter.

5th Grade

- Students served in Title Math who are at or near the 50th percentile on Easy CBM increased by 15% from fall to winter.

Concern Area:

- Only 26% of 3rd grade students served in Title I Math are at or near the 50th percentile on winter Easy CBM.

Next Steps:

- Title Math created a new group to support 3rd grade students who may or may not be at grade level on CBM master their math facts.
- Teachers have set goals aligned to the SIP for their students and are monitoring their progress. We will continue to review this data in our 6-week cycle meetings and collaborate with SPED and Title to support students.
- Teachers will use their SBA interim assessment data to help plan for instruction to support students in the targeted skill areas.

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Strategic Plan Goal: 2: Responsible, Resilient, Empowered Learners

Outcome: b. Increased percentage of regular school attenders.

Academic Gap Goal: The current gap between students identified as low income and non-low income who are regular attenders will decrease by 50% from June 2023 to June 2024 at each grade level.



Indicators of Progress:

- 1st grade has similar percentages of regular attenders in low income and non-low-income status.
- 4th grade has an increased percentage of regular attenders who are low income from spring of 2023 to Feb. 2024.
- Kindergarten has an increased percentage of regular attenders who are low income from spring of 2023 to Feb. 2024

Concern Area:

- Gaps between students who are low income and non-low income have increased in grades K, 2 and, 3.

Next Steps:

- Continue to attempt to remove barriers for attendance with our families.
- Incentivize all regular attenders for the first semester with a family pizza night in March.
- Continue our monthly attendance focus on staff and families.
- Continue having our teachers build strong connections with students and families.
