



#### What is Title I

In NTPS Title I is a K-5 program that provides additional academic support and learning opportunities for students at schools with high percentages of socioeconomically disadvantaged children. The program is intended to help ensure that all students meet state academic standards.


### Goals of Title I

## Parent Rights


- Review and modify the Title I Parent Involvement Policy


## School Achievement Data

- Schools analyze the SBA and local test results.
- Schools use the data to align curriculum to state and district academic standards.
- Schools adjust instructional practices based on the findings of the assessment data.



#### Title I Funds

- One percent of a school's total Title I budget is for parent involvement activities.
- Funds must supplement, not supplant, district funds.




#### The Title I Parent Involvement

Every Title I school, in collaboration with parents, must prepare a site level parent involvement policy. The Parent Involvement Policy describes how the school will involve the parents in an organized, ongoing, and timely way in the planning, review, and improvement of the Title I program at the school.


