If you are filling this out on a Chromebook:

1. Click “Download”
2. Click “Show in Folder” from the popup and then double-click on the file name to open it.
3. Fill out the form by typing into it and choosing from the drop-down menus. (when you click in some of the spaces you will see the arrow appear to open the drop-down menus)
4. When you are finished filling out the form, click the “Print” icon
 - a. Do not click "Download"!
5. For “Destination” select “Save as PDF” and then click “Save”
 - a. You can then save it to your Drive or your Computer
