### **LAST DAY FOR SENIORS**

The last day of school for graduating seniors will be Tuesday, June 14th. They will complete their checkout process and this completed form will serve as their pass into Graduation practice.

### **FINES & FEES**

All fines and fees are due by June 14th! Seniors with any outstanding fees and/or fines WILL NOT receive graduation tickets, be allowed to participate in the graduation ceremony, or receive a diploma until all fines and fees have been cleared. ### **MANDATORY GRADUATION PRACTICE**

There will be two mandatory graduation marching practices:

Wednesday, June 15th @ 8:30 am in the gym following Senior breakfast

Thursday, June 16th @ 9 am in the Marcus Pavilion at Saint Martin's

These are required for all seniors who will be walking at the Thursday, June 16th graduation ceremony.

### **TICKETS**

Each graduate will receive **6 tickets** for family and friends to attend the graduation ceremony. You must have all your fines/fees cleared and be on track to graduate to receive your tickets. Tickets will be distributed at lunch June 1 and 6th. Additional tickets can be requested through an online survey that will be available on June 3rd.

### **GRADUATION CEREMONY**

The RRHS graduation will be on Thursday, June 16th, at Saint Martin's University's Marcus Pavilion. The ceremony will begin at 7:00 pm sharp. Each student will be given tickets for their guests. Guests who are attending the ceremony will be required to show their ticket at the door.

### **COMMENCEMENT GUIDELINES**

Commencement is the culminating ceremony for years of learning & a formal occasion to be enjoyed by seniors and their families. In keeping with the tone of this occasion, no air horns or other noise making devices are allowed. Graduates and guests will not be permitted to bring balloons in Marcus Pavilion (it is against St. Martin's rules). We ask all guests to remember that graduation is a traditional, formal ceremony. We thank you in advance for helping our seniors to commemorate this important event in their lives.

### **ATTIRE**

All seniors will wear blue caps and gowns for the graduation ceremony. You can still order if you have not already done so ([Jostens Link](#)). Orders need to be placed by 5/19 for delivery on 5/23 to the school. Aside from cords or medallions awarded by RRHS, no other adornment will be allowed on caps or gowns. If you have a cultural adornment that you would like to include please talk with the administration so that we are aware.
