Free Breakfast and Lunch will be available

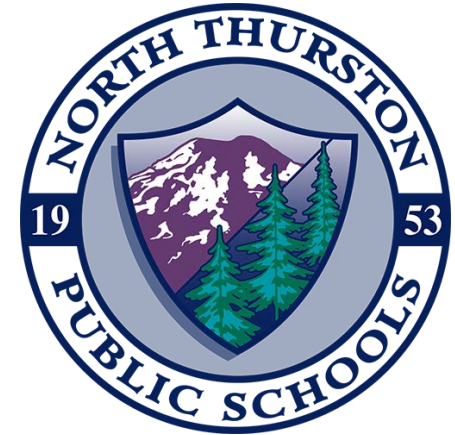
Summer Courses DO NOT meet NCAA eligibility

POTENTIAL ONLINE COURSES

Course material will be delivered to students using APEX online learning and most course material is done independently. Students may choose to work online from home, but must be able to physically be at THS to take their exams between 8:30-12:00 with a test proctor when needed. Students may also work online at THS daily during class hours. Teachers are available for support.

All online classes are only available for credit retrieval*. Students must have previously attempted the course with it showing as failed on the student's transcript.
