

POLICY – BOARD SUPPORT OF THE SUPERINTENDENT

BSR-7

The Board of Directors will ensure that there is a mechanism in place to provide input, dialogue, support and development for the Superintendent by:

- Monitoring the Superintendent's results (through the Monitoring Superintendent Performance Policy) to provide feedback on results achieved contributing to the Superintendent's learning.
- Being available to the Superintendent to discuss competing Ends priorities as needed and to give input to redefining priorities among the Ends as required.
- Being available for consultation and support through, informal discussion with the Board as requested by the Superintendent for learning purposes. (Note: The Superintendent is not obligated to follow any particular course of action as a result of these informal, consultation discussions).
- Providing reasonable resources and support for the ongoing learning and professional development of the Superintendent in areas relevant to achievement of the North Thurston Public Schools Board Ends Policies.
