

Hybrid 1st Grade Tidbits

Helpful information and tips for Hybrid 1st Grade

Safety Protocols

- Face masks **MUST** be worn **ALL DAY** while at school. They can remove them to eat lunch. Please send several masks in a plastic sandwich baggy so your child can change them throughout the day as needed. (Ex. wet ones from recess)
- Desks will be 6 feet apart and students will have space to use the floor area around their desk.
- We will be washing hands at arrival, after recesses, before and after lunch, and prior to dismissal.
- We will be teaching students to only touch their own supplies and to keep their "bubble" around them.

Routines

- We will have 2 recesses, brain breaks, and stretching activities throughout the day.

Lunch/Drinks

- Lunch will be eaten in the classroom, at your child's desk. They may bring a lunch from home or receive a school lunch. School lunch includes milk.
- Please send a water bottle each day with your child. We will not be using the drinking fountain, but they may refill their water bottle at the tap. Please no juice in water bottles due to sticky spills.
- Breakfast will not be served at school; however, it will be passed out at the end of the school day for the following morning. **Please let me know if you do not want your child to bring home a breakfast.**

Items to send

- Light coat with a hood and a hat with a brim to wear under the hood (They will be going outside for recess and will be standing outside, uncovered, at the end of the day for dismissal.)
- A sweatshirt for the classroom
- Water bottle
- Lunch or a plan for school lunch
- Backpack
- Change of clothes in case of accidents or wet recess (remains in backpack)

- Several masks in a plastic baggy
- Shoes for cold, wet weather without ties if your child can't tie.
- Please label ALL your child's belongings
