

2nd Grade Hybrid Information for Parents

Helpful information and tips for Hybrid 2nd Grade, from Ms. Vegas and Mrs. Michaelis.

Pick-up & Drop off:

Parents dropping off and picking up their child will be given a red laminated sign with your child's name and class on it. These should be placed on your dashboard. Staff will be looking to these to see if you have completed your child's wellness screening in the morning. At pick up they will be used to see your child's name in order to quickly get your child to your car.

Safety Protocols

- You **must** complete your child's Wellness Screening on each in-school day prior to 7:45am.
- Face masks **MUST** be worn **ALL DAY** while at school. They can remove them to eat lunch. Please send several masks in a plastic sandwich baggy so your child can change them throughout the day as needed. (Ex. wet ones from recess)
- Desks will be 6 feet apart. We will do our very best to maintain this throughout the day.
- We will be washing hands at arrival, after recesses, after bathroom use, before and after lunch, and prior to dismissal.
- We will be teaching students to **ONLY** touch their own supplies and to keep their "bubble" around them.
- We are not having students bring supplies back and forth from school to home. We have pencil boxes with supplies here ready to go for their classroom days. Please leave your child's Chromebook at home as they will need it on their asynchronous home instructional days.

Routines

- We will have 2 recesses, brain breaks, and stretching activities throughout the day.
- We will attempt to give individual students a "mask break" on an as needed basis just outside in our covered breezeway while the door remains open in our classroom. We will stand in the doorway to supervise the class mask free "zone".

Lunch/Drinks

- Lunch will be eaten in the classroom, at your child's desk. They may bring a lunch from home or receive a school lunch. School lunch includes milk.
- Please send a water bottle each day with your child. We will not be using the drinking fountain, but they may refill their water bottle at the tap. Please no juice in water bottles due to sticky spills.

- Breakfast will not be served at school; however, it will be passed out at the end of the school day for the following morning. Please let me know if you do NOT want your child to bring home a breakfast.

Items to send

- Reach For Reading Purple Anthology
- Math Journal
- White Board and Markers (if they still work)
- Light coat with a hood. (They will be going outside for recess and will be standing outside, uncovered, at the end of the day for dismissal.)
- Water bottle (This will be taken home daily.)
- Lunch or a plan for school lunch
- Backpack
- Several masks in a plastic baggy (this will remain in their backpack)
- Shoes for cold, wet weather without ties if your child can't tie.
- Please label ALL your child's belongings

Classroom Supplies

We are asking for donations of some school supplies to get us through the rest of the school year. Please DO NOT put your child's name on the supplies. They will be shared among the kids as we run out. You can donate at any time by dropping at the office with your teacher's name or sending with your child in a bag. Supplies needed:

Birthday Celebrations

We will celebrate your child on their birthday. We will celebrate summer birthdays in June. If you would like to send a birthday treat with your child to share with the class, it **must** be store bought! Please also contact us in advance (prior to the day of....) to let us know.

Homework

Your child will be given a Homework Folder on their first day of school. This will be used to transport their **Planner Page** (see below), any notes, homework (unfinished assignments), or

school information between you and your child's teacher. This is their responsibility and we teach them that this folder "lives" in their backpack.

Planner Page

Like the Homework Folder that "lives" in your child's backpack, their Planner Page "lives" in your child's folder. The Planner Page is an excellent form of communication between you, your child, and their teacher and is checked by us daily. Please feel free to jot any notes on their Planner Page if you need to convey a message to us for the day. In addition, we ask that your child read 20 minutes a day a minimum of 4 days a week. This will be recorded on their Planner Page, which has a box next to each day of the week for you to sign and confirm that they have read their 20 minutes. All students who return their Planner Page signed by an adult on a daily basis will receive a P.A.W.S. ticket which will be put in for our classroom prize drawing done every Friday during our remote Morning Meeting time.

Dismissal and absences

- Please call the front office if your child is going to be absent
- Please call the front office if there is a change in dismissal transportation
- **Please note....** On days that your child is not present in the classroom (asynchronous days) they must log into their Google Classroom and complete the lessons and assignments that are posted for that day. In addition, they **MUST** complete the Attendance Form for by midnight that day in order to be counted as present. If they do not complete the form they will be marked as absent.

Title or Special Education Groups:

If your child is assigned to a Reading or Math Title Groups, they will also be on asynchronous days. Reading Groups being at 11:00am, Math Groups will begin at 12:00pm. You will be notified if your child is in one of these groups and will receive an invite from their assigned teacher's *Google Classroom*.
