Every student will demonstrate continuous growth towards meeting/exceeding rigorous learning standards

Outcome: C: Increased growth rate of underperforming groups eliminating achievement and opportunity gaps

Academic Gap Goal: By June 2024, we will close the Kindergarten through Fifth Grade reading achievement gap for students who qualify for Free and Reduced Lunches and those who do not by decreasing the Low Risk reading gap on the easyCBM by 10% from 16% to 6%.

Actions:

- Professional development will be provided in Teacher Clarity, Success Criteria, to support access to core curriculum instruction.
- Professional development will be provided to staff on Science of Reading practices to increase student access to core instruction in developing background knowledge, morphological awareness, vocabulary, and decoding.
- Staff will continue deconstructing ELA and Math standards to develop learning intentions, success criteria, and assessments.
- Explicit Foundational Skill instruction will happen in grades K-2, including Heggerty in as an intervention in K-2.
- Grades 3-5 will focus on best practices in vocabulary and developing background knowledge instruction.
- Instructional Research Committee will be focusing on creating a K-5 Vocabulary List including Latin and Greek root words and prefixes and suffixes and morphology.
- We will utilize a cohesive and collaborative MTSS team and process to analyze data and goals throughout the year.
- Equity Professional Development for staff centered on Since Time Immemorial and Ethnic Studies

Strategic Plan Goal: Goal 2: Responsible, Resilient, Empowered Learners

Outcome: Outcome b. Increased percentage of regular school attenders

Social Emotional Gap Goal: We will improve the attendance of our low-income students from 26% regular attenders to at least 43% (matching that of their non-low-income peers), by Spring 2024

Actions:

- Establish Intervention Team
- Meet bi-monthly to track and discuss students who are at risk for becoming chronic.
- Messaging systems posters, Monday Memo, Family Connection meetings, FB
- Relationship building teachers communicating regularly with absent students' families personal connections calling if a student has missed 2 or more days.
- Classroom rewards for attendance
- Rewarding students who are at school with pop up celebrations.
- Early intervention with students who are close to being at risk letters, calls, meetings with admin.

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
