### **Young Child and Family Center**

Attendees reviewed tentative plans for the Young Child & Family Center (YCFC) of Lacey. A joint project of NTPS, the YMCA, and the City of Lacey, the YCFC will fill a critical need for early childhood resources in Thurston County. The facility may include:

- Early learning classrooms, offering family-friendly parenting and nutrition classes
- Indoor and outdoor play areas
- Indoor aquatics area and outdoor playground
- And more...








